The North Sea Region (NSR) is facing a significant increase in the frequency and severity of floods in response to climate change. Flood management approaches have to urgently adapt to this new reality to keep people safe, the environment healthy and our economies prosperous. To respond to this challenge Ringkøbing aims at a C2C (Cloud-To-Coast) approach to manage present and future flood risk. C2C is a whole-system approach recognizing that opportunities to build resilience to flooding from the rain falls (Cloud) to flow through the rural catchment and the urban cities, before interacting with coastal storms (Coast). It links the four constituent systems (catchment, coasts, cities, infrastructure networks) and enables the development of multifunctional and adaptable solutions that deliver more sustainable, integrated, and multifunctional solutions across the NSR.
